Specialist Leaders of Education (SLEs) are outstanding middle or senior leaders, with at least two years' leadership experience, who have the skills to support individuals or teams in specific subject areas and specialisms.

Over 70 accredited SLEs are designated with Partners in Learning Teaching School Alliance across Primary and Secondary. Our SLEs undergo a thorough recruitment process and induction and receive termly training to enhance their knowledge and expertise as leaders.

When you contact us requesting support we will identify a System Leader with suitable skills and experience to provide the level of support required, liaising with the SLE and their school's Headteacher to ensure they have the capacity and availability to carry out the deployment.

Models and types of deployments will vary. Deployments could comprise of a single visit, a few days or may cover more significant periods with the SLE deployed in a school for one day per week for a whole term to provide bespoke support.

All SLEs deployed from Partners in Learning will be monitored for the quality of the support they provide. A QA Adviser will be involved throughout the whole process, attending initial meetings to discuss the requirements of the school and drawing up deployment contracts through to monitoring paperwork and offering guidance to both the SLE and receiving school during the deployment.
