The overarching aim of a review is to be developmental, enhancing leadership capacity within school and building sustainable models of school improvement. It will be a partnership approach, where coaching is used to support school leaders in the acquisition of key skills.

Two external advisers will work together on the review, a school with up to eight classes would normally be allocated three adviser days at a cost of £1500. Two advisers will spend one full day in school working alongside senior leaders to conduct the review. One additional day is allocated to preparation and report writing.

A larger school would typically require two additional adviser days to complete the process and would cost £2500.
